Sample Interview Questions

When interviewing a person to assist you with communication, it might be useful to ask them what they would do or say in some common situations. For example: What would you do or say if:

- Someone I wanted to communicate with, directed all their questions and comments to you and didn't look at me
- A person thinks I can't hear and talks loudly to me
- A person is being rude
- A doctor asks you to step out of the room when examining me
- You don't agree with what I asked you to tell someone
- People keep talking at a meeting and I want to communicate something
- You are going to be late for a meeting
- You don't understand what I am communicating
- A doctor asks you to give permission to treat me
