Communication Assistance Course

This course is about ways to assist individuals who have speech and language disabilities if they need support communicating with people.

Anyone who supports a person with a communication disability in the community and/or is a:

- Personal Support Worker
- Personal Attendant
- Communication Disorders Assistant
- Communication Health Assistant
- Direct Service Professional
- Family Member
- Friend
- Disability Advocate
- Student in a Disability Area

In addition, a person with a communication disability can take this course to help them train their personal assistants.

There are 6 lessons in this course. Lessons can take from 20 minutes to an hour to complete.
